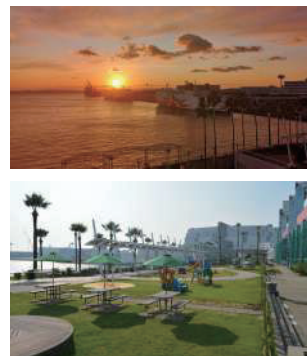

A relaxing area spanning 450-meters in width looking out to the shoreline and open space.



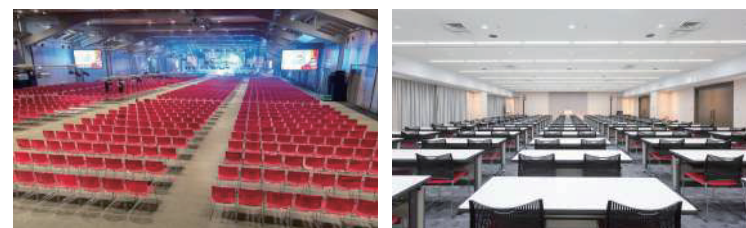
Event Halls

- Hall E : 250 m²



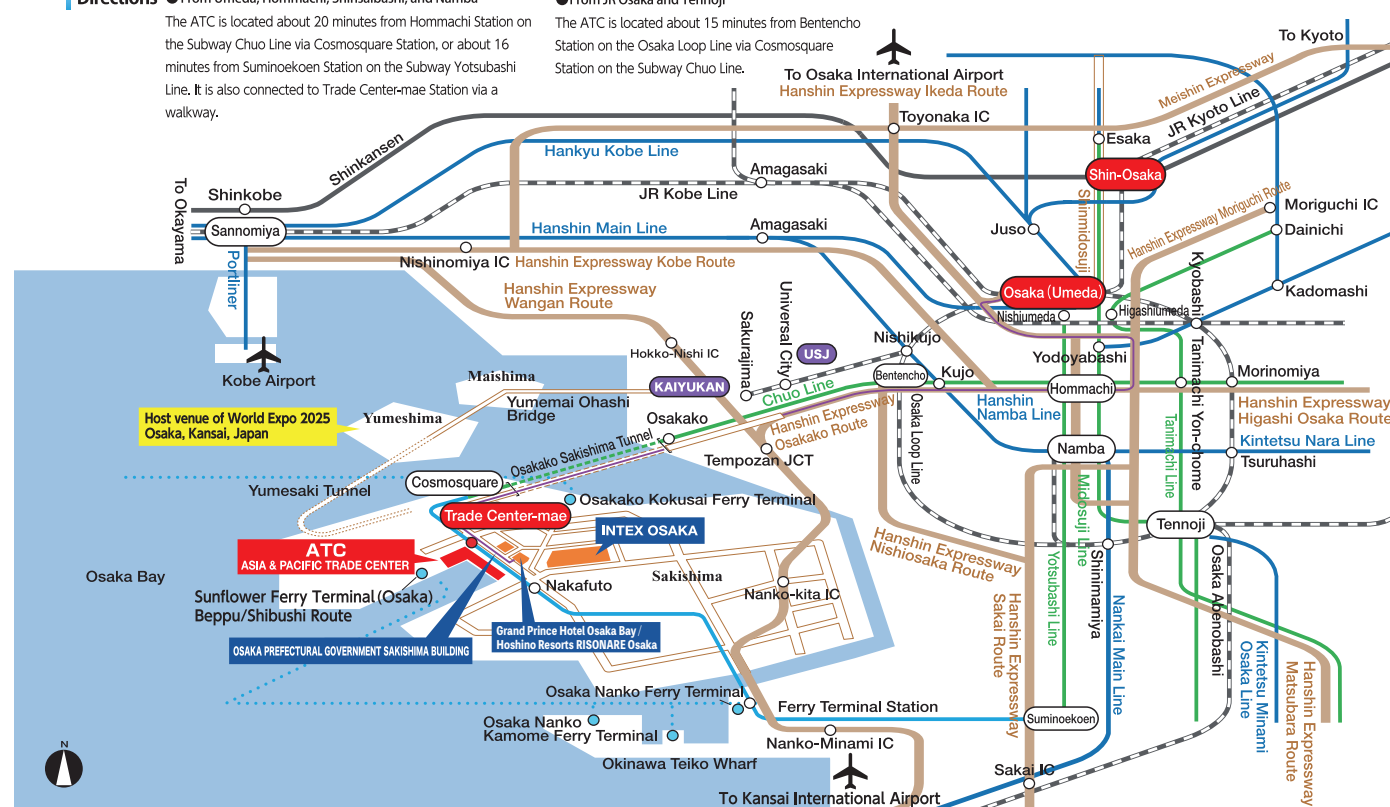

The ATC is located about 20 minutes from Hommachi Station on the Subway Chuo Line via Cosmosquare Station, or about 16 minutes from Suminoekoen Station on the Subway Yotsubashi Line. It is also connected to Trade Center-mae Station via a walkway.

● From JR Osaka and Tennoji

The ATC is located about 15 minutes from Bentencho Station on the Osaka Loop Line via Cosmosquare Station on the Subway Chuo Line.

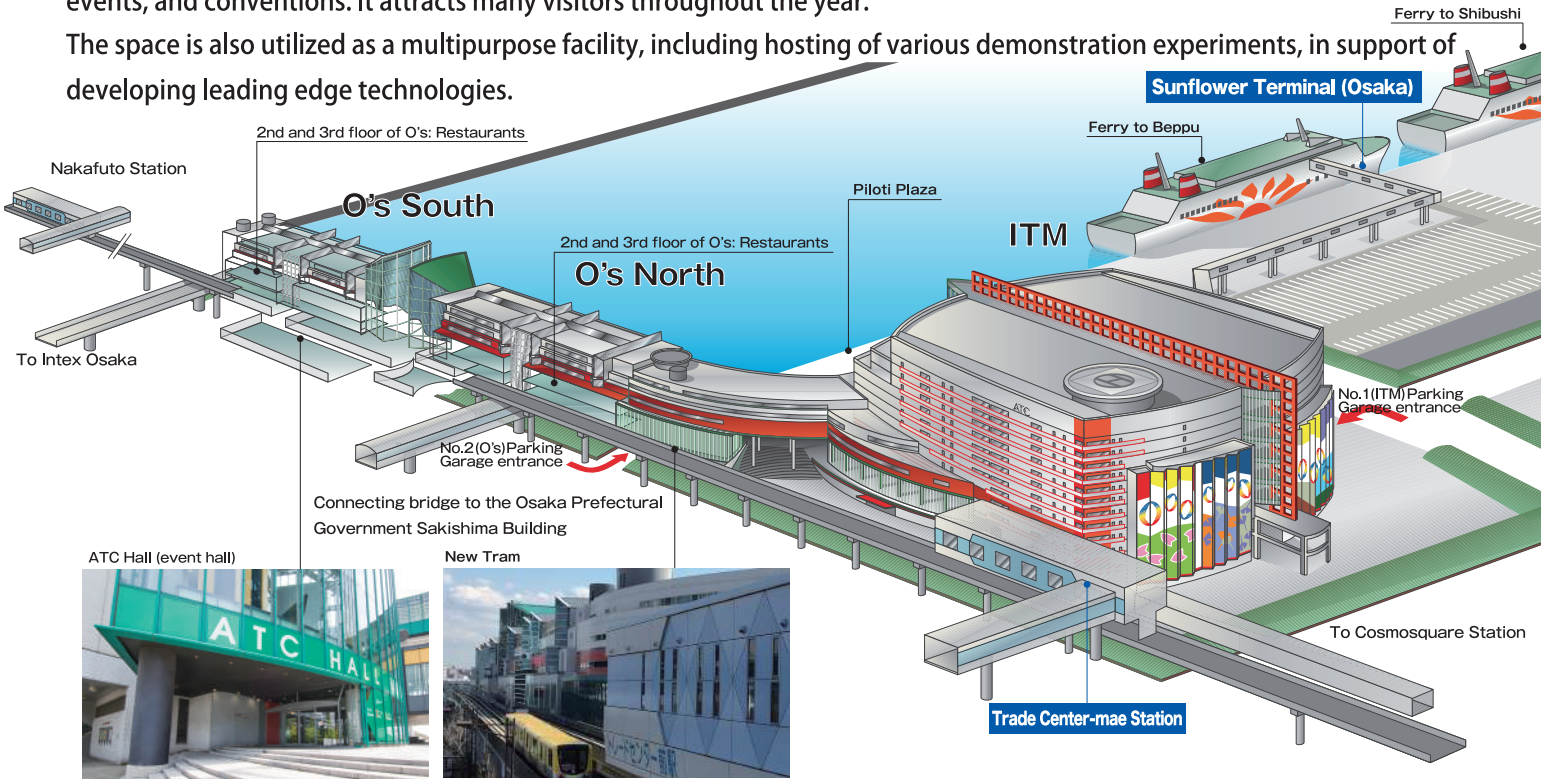

Asia and Pacific Trade Center Co., Ltd. operates the Asia and Pacific Trade Center (ATC), a large commercial complex in an outstanding, seaside location in Osaka's Sakishima district. It is closely located to the host venue of World Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai, Japan. We are working to revitalize the Kansai region's economy through our core businesses of real estate leasing, property management, and operations; operating permanent exhibits and business incubation facilities; renting out event halls; and planning and holding various events.

The ATC consists of the ITM Building and O's Building. The ITM Building houses offices along with showrooms related to furniture, interior furnishings, home equipment, and environmental and health-related products. The O's Building houses a variety of restaurants and shops as well as ATC Hall, a multipurpose exhibition space, which hosts exhibitions, entertainment events, and conventions. It attracts many visitors throughout the year.

The space is also utilized as a multipurpose facility, including hosting of various demonstration experiments, in support of developing leading edge technologies.

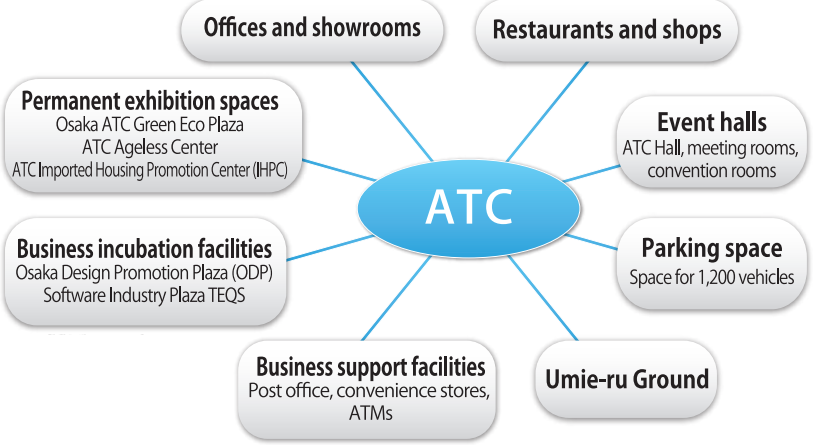

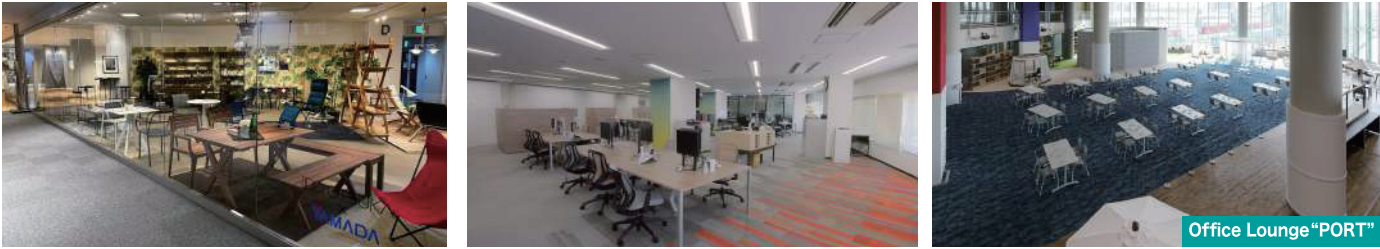
